## Rec Alley terms and conditions

Enrolment terms and conditions assist in ensuring the safety, consistent value and mission can be achieved. On acceptance of this agreement, the purchaser will accept Rec Alley terms and conditions for products or services which will change from time to time. If you purchase services or the use of facilities at Rec Alley on behalf of another person, you and that other person both agree that you make that purchase as the authorised agent of that other person so that he/she will be bound by these conditions. Participants, purchasers and or responsible person's rights and obligations can be found detailed below:

- 1.1 By purchasing or participating in services or the use of facilities at Rec Alley, the customer agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 1.2 Customers acknowledge the dangers associated with recreational activity with many associated risks or hazards. Personal injury and or death can occur as a result of activity. The customer assumes and accepts the risks associated with recreational activity and hereby waives the right to sue Rec Alley for any personal injury or death in any way whatsoever caused by or related to the customers participation in activity. This includes the participant and assisting or participating guardian.
- 1.3 Due to the dangers involved in recreational activity, using activity equipment or physical activity in general, there is significant risk for participants to suffer serious personal injury, permanent disability or death. All participants who engage in Rec Alley activity do so at their own risk.
- 1.4 Any Rec Alley employee, volunteer, director or associated agent are not liable to any customer, dependant or legal representative for injury or death suffered because of recreational activities. This includes care or skill not fit for purpose due to negligence, or statutory duty to the extent provided for by law (Australian consumer law and fair trading act 2012).
- 1.5 Customers and or visitors to Rec Alley agrees to pay the cost of and authorises Rec Alley to take all steps considered necessary to protect the welfare of the individual in the event of personal injury. This includes the administration of any medical treatment and emergency services transportation.
- 1.6 Participants must be in good health to participate in activity. Any customer not in good health, has pre-existing health conditions, or may be pregnant participate at their own risk and may not be permitted to participate in activity at the discretion of Rec Alley staff. Medical clearance and advice to participate in any activity is strongly recommended and those that do not seek medical advice and participate in activity do so at their own risk. This includes parents or caregivers supporting a child during activity
- 1.7 The customer including all participants or visitors must comply with all policies, conditions, signs or other directions of Rec Alley. Suspension or cancellation of the customer's and a participant's access to recreational activities is at the discretion of Rec Alley for non-compliance with these conditions, including reckless or careless conduct.

**Arrivals, departure and supervision.** Starting: Warm up is a critical component to any physical activity. Participants are encouraged to arrive and be ready five minutes prior to class commencement. All participants, parents or visitors who are waiting for a class to commence or have finished a class must not be on the gymnastics floor or equipment.

**Finishing:** Participants should be collected inside the building by parents and or guardians, and are not permitted to wait anywhere other than inside the building for parents who are outside. Rec Alley encourages parents to reinforce this behaviour with their children.

**Responsibility:** Rec Alley is not a child minding service. Given this, parents or care givers should remain onsite and easily accessible while children under the age of 18 years participate in classes. Rec Alley accepts no responsibility for children dropped off early or picked up late from class. Guardians must be over the age of 18 years old, actively supervise their children while in Rec Alley venue or participating in Rec Alley activity, and are responsible for taking children to the toilet/change room. Children under the age of 10 years must be escorted to class and collected at the end of class, with an adult or caregiver. Rec Alley accepts no responsibility for children outside the Rec Alley venue including carpark or other areas, as the parent and or caregiver must maintain responsibility and safety of the child.

**Parking and carpark safety.** Consideration and care must be taken for safe driving, and walking around the carpark. With young children around the Rec Alley building, responsible conduct while driving a vehicle is critical. Rec Alley will not tolerate any illegal or dangerous driving or parking. Visitors should avoid parking in private car spaces. Important things to remember while in the car park; children's behaviour in the car park is learnt, only park in permitted provisional areas, drive slowly, be patient, alert, and aware of your surroundings, parents are responsible for escorting children safely to and from class, enter the car park at the left driveway and exit at the right drive way – clockwise direction, do not park in front of any fire exits, roller doors, or private car spaces (signed or marked).

**Photography & Electronic Devices.** Photos and filming of classes is not permitted in Rec Alley without approval. While in a Rec Alley venue, or participating in associated Rec Alley activity, you consent to images and video being taken for security or promotional purposes of yourself, your children or of children for whom you are responsible.

**Conduct.** Rec Alley reserves the right to refuse entry, cancel a membership or request any visitor to leave the premises for those that do not behave in a responsible manner or in line with Rec Alley values, is under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol, or does not adhere to conditions of entry.

**Correct Apparel.** Participants are to wear suitable sports clothes or permitted uniform to Rec Alley activity. Long hair should be tied back and jewellery should be removed. For participant safety, clothing with denim, buttons, or zips cannot be worn. Rec Alley takes no responsibility for lost property. Visitors are advised not to bring any valuables to the Rec Alley facility. Lost property items will be placed in Rec Alley lost property basket, and disposed at the end of each term.

- 1.1 The event will start at 5:45PM and conclude at 9:15PM on Saturday 20 June, 2019
- 1.2 Rec Alley reserves the right to amend the event date and times.
- 1.3 The price per participant is \$20
- 1.4 Children must be between 5 and 16 years old
- 1.5 A non-member must be accompanied by a member gymnast (for example a sibling or friend of a gymnast)
- 1.6 All parents of participants must sign the waiver form
- 1.7 All participants that are not members must have a casual sign in form completed before participating
- 1.8 Parents must drop participants off no later than 6PM and pick up participants no later than 9:15PM
- 1.9 Rec Alley collection policies apply for children not picked up by 9:45PM which includes contacting suitable authorities
- 1.10 A parent or guardian must sign in and sign out children in their care at the reception desk
- 1.11 If the participant pickup is by an adult who is not a parent or guardian, Rec Alley must be provided with those details before pick up
- 2.0 Parents must advise of any allergies or dietary requirements as the children will have access to light snacks and refreshments
